



**PRAYER
GUIDE**
FOR ISRAEL

1. Prayer for the government of Israel, its president, and government cabinet, military leaders, and religious leaders. So that their confidence and their strength may be in Jehovah. We ask that God give them the confidence and fear of Jehovah that King David had as he faced his enemies. David declared: those trust in chariots and others in horses, but we will remember the name of Jehovah, we ask that their trust and their strength depend on God and not on his military power, his achievements, his political alliances or their strength. We ask that they don't abandon the covenant, but that in every meeting and planning they will remember **Psalms 37:5-6** *“Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act. He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.”*

2. For the liberation of the kidnapped people and comfort for those who lost their loved ones. May the hand of God intervene in a supernatural way. In the same way that Israel saw the hand of God in the past, may those kidnapped be freed, and may they return to their homes safe and sound. Because it is not by force or army but by your holy Spirit, Lord you can do the impossible and show yourself once again as Jehovah Sabaot the general of the armies of Israel. **Psalms 80:18-19** *“Then we shall not turn back from you; give us life, and we will call upon your name! Restore us, O Lord God of hosts! Let your face shine, that we may be saved!”*

3. For spiritual salvation for Israel. May the messiah be revealed in dreams and visions to every Jew in Israel, especially to families who are currently suffering from the loss or kidnapping of their loved ones. Let their gaze be towards heaven from where help comes, from Jehovah who made the heavens and the earth. We ask that their spiritual blindness be removed, their veil removed and their messiah seen, that the scriptures be revealed and that his spirit be awakened. We pray for revelation in the knowledge of Jesus Christ, enlighten the eyes of their understanding according to **Ephesians 1:17**

4. For a sincere repentance in the hearts of the Jews, for a new heart according to the promise of the new covenant. **Ezekiel 36:26-28** *“And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God.”*

5. For revelation, repentance and salvation to Hamas militants. Open the eyes that are blinded by hatred and a false religion. So that they can see their evil and an awakening to the truth of your word. Reveal yourself in dreams and visions, allow them to see the truth, illuminate all darkness with your light and let the spirit of error and lies fall by its weight. **2 Corinthians 4:6** *“For God, who said, “Let light shine out of darkness,” has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”*

6. So that the hearts of the Jews can forgive and not be carried away by the same spirit of hatred, revenge and evil of their attackers. Let them experience forgiveness through the sacrifice of Jesus so they can grant forgiveness and extend mercy. **Ephesians 4:31-32** *“Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.”*

7. We pray for conversions among the Arabs in the Middle East especially the Palestinians. Let the indoctrination to hate Jews fall under its own weight. Let there be reconciliation between Arabs and Jews. May the Islamic extremists, their doctrine, their lies, their hypocrisy, their evil, and their demonic bond, be rejected and condemned by their own people. We ask that their eyes be opened, and their ears exposed to the truth, and that all lies be rejected. We ask that lies fall like scales from their eyes and the gospel of truth come, and that in the midst of war the gospel that brings reconciliation and peace may be received. **Galatians 3:28** *“There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.”*

8. We pray for the spiritual leaders of Israel. We ask for revelation in the knowledge of Jesus Christ and so that all blindness due to religiosity and the commands of men may be removed. May the truth bring even more light to your speeches and may their influence grow as their love for God increases. We pray for a spiritual awakening, and for prophets, teachers, evangelists, pastors and apostles to arise in Israel. We ask that prophetic voices be raised in Israel, which will lead many to the truth in your word and a preparation of hearts among the people. We pray for a heart of mercy towards his enemies, and that the teaching of forgiveness be emphasized in every teaching and sermon. We ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit as on the day of Pentecost, where Jews from many regions were seeking God in prayer and suddenly the holy spirit descended with flames of fire. We ask for the same experience, we ask that you raise up the Elijahs of this time among the people of Israel, prophets with zeal for God. We pray for the Davids, kings after your heart. We ask for the Maccabees, priests to cleanse and consecrate holy things. We ask for the John the Baptist who prepares the way, and who prepares the heart for the coming of the Messiah. We pray for the Estevans who call for reconciliation and forgiveness. We ask for the waters of cleansing and purification for Israel, the removal of all idols, the spirit of error, religiosity, idolatry, and especially the removal of the influence of the new age and eastern religions. **Ezekiel 36:25-28** *“I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God”*

9. We pray for a forgiving heart among Jews. Those who lost their loved ones, those who have their relatives in captivity and those who still remember the Holocaust, the inquisition, the hatred of the radical Islamic and their Jihad with resentment in their hearts. Let them know forgiveness through Jesus Christ, and may they say “just as we were forgiven, so we forgive.” We pray for consolation and peace in their hearts, and to be reminded that “vengeance is from Jehovah.” We pray against any spirit of retaliation, where the inhabitants of Gaza are being taken as an after-effect of the war. We ask that Israel adopt the position of mercy, and forgiveness, and not returning evil for evil, although defending their territory from their enemies. Just as the eyes of the world are currently on Israel, let the world know mercy, forgiveness and reconciliation through example. We ask that you will remind them that Israel is a people of kings and priests, the salt of the earth and the light of the world, and that the world is watching and witnessing their responses. We ask that the words of the prophet Micah resonate in his spirit: **Micah 6:8-9** *“He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? The voice of the Lord cries to the city—and it is sound wisdom to fear your name: “Hear of the rod and of him who appointed it!”*
